- 2009 – 2010 USA Hockey Membership
- USA Hockey, Coaching Education Program, Level 2 Certification (Level 3 certification is highly recommended)

All coaches involved with the league must be registered with USA Hockey for the 2009 – 10 season. No coach may go on the ice, nor bench, if they do not have this registration number on file. Registration can be completed at the above website.

The objective of the Coaching Education Program is to improve the caliber and quality of coaching in amateur hockey. Five levels of achievement have been established to educate and train each coach, from the beginner to the highly skilled expert. This year, the HP High School League is requiring that all coaches attain a minimum Level 2 certification. A Level 3 Certification is highly recommended and will be required next season.
