General Information

Sharks Ice is proud to bring you the tenth season of the HP High School Hockey League, the premier high school ice hockey league in Northern California. We offer two separate divisions, a Junior Varsity and a Varsity division. Unlike traditional high school sports, where Junior Varsity and Varsity are decided by age, our divisions are grouped exclusively by skill level. The Junior Varsity division will be made up of recreational/in-house/low end travel level players, while the Varsity division will be comprised of high end travel/tier level players. No matter of your skill level, we have a spot for you.

All players must be currently enrolled in high school in Northern California and must provide all of their own HECC approved equipment. Practices and games will take place at Sharks Ice at San Jose and at the Oakland Ice Center. Most games will take place on weekends with an occasional game being played mid-week.

Junior Varsity Division:

- Individual sign up players will be evaluated the week of November 2nd, 2009
- Games begin late November and run to early April
- Season consists of 18 practices, 15 games, plus playoffs
- Cost for individual sign ups is \$695 which includes two sets of jerseys and socks

Varsity Division

- Practices will begin in mid February
- Games begin early March and run to early May
- Seasons consists of 12 practices, 12 games, plus playoff
- Cost for individual sign ups is \$545 which includes two sets of jerseys and socks
